**Theme: Be Doers of the Word and not Hearers Only**

In 1962 -1965, the Church convened the Council of Vatican II  
 to reflect on the life of the Church. And the Council **pro-  
 duced 16 documents** that calls for renewal of the Church.  
 Among those documents there was one on the issue of the  
 word of God, "Dei Verbum."

The Second Vatican Council document on Dogmatic constitu-  
 tion on Divine Revelation [Dei Verbum], affirmed that "*In his  
 goodness and wisdom God choose to reveal himself and to  
 make known to us the hidden purpose of his will by which  
 through Christ, the word made flesh, man might in the Holy  
 Spirit have access to the Father and come to share in the di-  
 vine nature.*"

In this purpose **God established the Church as his gift to  
 the people** he created in his image and likeness. He speaks to  
 people like a friend and lives among them. And through the  
 Church he invites us to share in his divine and holy life.

Indeed, the Sacred Scripture is the word of God inspired by  
 the divine Spirit, together with Sacred Tradition that comes  
 from the Apostles and develops in the Church, **form one sa-  
 cred deposit of the word of God.** The Sacred Scripture were  
 written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, they have God  
 as their author and were handed on to the Church.

In composing the Sacred Books, God choose men who made  
 use their powers and abilities to write those things that God  
 wanted. So, the Bible is the inspired word of God, which  
*teach solidly, faithfully and without error the truth which God  
 wanted to put in the sacred writing for the sake of our salva-  
 tion.*

Now, in his intention God wanted us to hear attentively to his  
 words and by hearing it, we **may come to know his will and  
 be filled with the knowledge of truth.** Then by hearing the  
 message of salvation, the whole world may believe, by believ-  
 ing it may hope and by hoping it may love. For the word of  
**God is the mirror of the soul**, which shows one's conformity  
 or lack of it to the requirements of Christian behavior.

Moreover, God wanted us to **be good Samaritans** of his  
 words, he wanted us to **serve the least** of his kingdom, he  
 wanted us to be the people moved by spirit of beatitudes, **pos-  
 sessing poor spirit**, to be **meek, merciful or peacemaker**, to  
 hunger or thirst for **righteousness**, and to possess **clean heart**  
 for the sake of Jesus Christ.

For this reason, the St. James 1: 22-24, proclaim loudly, "**Be  
 doers of the word and not hearers** only, deluding your-  
 selves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he  
 is like a man who looks at his own face in a mirror. He sees  
 himself, then goes off and promptly forgets what he looked  
 like." so, let's strive to put God's word in actions. *Fr. Thad*
