

Baptism: Please call the church office for appointment at least two months prior to date. A prep class is required. Parents should contact Deacon William Pouncy.

RCIA: Adults Seeking Baptism and/or Making a Profession in the Catholic Christian Faith should contact Deacon Greg Shumpert.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office before setting your date. The Church asks that couples be parish members for at least 6 months before setting a date. Participation in Pre-Cana and a Premarital Inventory required.

Funerals: Please contact the parish office before going to see a Funeral Director. We will accommodate the needs of your family to help you through the loss and healing.

Ministry to Sick and Shut-In/ Anointing of the Sick/ Home Visitation/Receiving Communion at Home: If you or a loved one is in need of a minister from St. Agatha-St. Martin de Porres to visit for Communion, Anointing of the Sick or any other pastoral need, please contact the church office as soon as the need arises. From the Desk of Fr. Larry...

My friends, listen to these words from St. Paul in today's First Reading. Listen to Jesus, speaking through St. Paul addressing <u>you</u>: "My beloved: I remind you, to stir into flame the gift of God that you have through the imposition of my hands. For God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather of power and love and self-control. So do not be ashamed of your testimony to our Lord, nor of me, a prisoner for his sake; but bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God. Take as your norm the sound words that you heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. Guard this rich trust with the help of the Holy Spirit that dwells within us."

Have you ever thought of the gift of faith as a rich trust, a source from which you can constantly make withdrawals to get you through the many hills and valleys of life? Faith is an incredible gift, fortified even more by the gift of a strong and vibrant faith community. I find it fascinating that Jesus refers to the incredible power of faith as small as a mustard seed. It begs the question of each of us: How large is your faith? Or perhaps a better question, what are you doing to nurture the seed of faith planted in you at Baptism? Is it something that is still germinating? Is it growing? Is it wilting? Does it need some watering with the Word of God, some rich soil in which to grow and flourish? How has your faith born fruit for you and for others? Are you working to deepen and strengthen the roots of faith in order for the power of God united with your gifts to stretch to touch even more people with the power of God's forgiveness, mercy and love? What do you need to do, as Paul invites, to stir into flame the power of love that God has given you uniquely to share?

Jesus pushes his disciples – that's each and all of us – to ask ourselves the question: Are we doing all that the Lord asks of us in opening ourselves to embrace the power of His love, to let that love germinate and grow within us, and then let it find expression in our care for ourselves and others, especially those who are in greater need than we are?

Jesus is not trying to guilt or shame us. He just knows that there is incredible potential for good in each of us. He knows because God, our Creator, put it there. Jesus longs for us to partner with the Holy Spirit to release the full power of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, united with our unique gifts, to add our unique value to the world, a world so much in need of such deep faith, boundless hope and redemptive love.
