



Baptism: Please call the church office for appointment at least two months prior

Marriage: Please contact the parish office before setting your date. The Church asks that couples be parish members for at least 6 months before setting a date. Participation in Pre-Cana and a Premarital Inventory required.

Hospital Stays: If you or a loved one is going into the hospital, please notify the office in order that a priest or care minister can call or visit the patient and be support to the family.



From the Desk of Fr. Larry...

My brothers and sisters, the Gospel for this Sunday presents Jesus with his disciples before they begin Jesus' final journey to Jerusalem. He is explaining to His disciples that He will soon leave them, reassuring them that the Father has a 'dwelling place' reserved for them in heaven, "so that where I am, you also may be." Then He reiterates to them that they know the way to get there, essentially saying that <u>He</u> is the Way, the Truth and the Life." Essentially, Jesus is telling them that heaven is not just a place, but a life-giving all loving eternal relationship with the Father and Him, and with all people who have followed the Way.

He explains to them that they have seen the Father, because He and the Father are One. He also points out to them that they have a great task ahead of them, that they will carry on His legacy of selfless love and, in an amazing statement: "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these, because I am going to the Father." Do greater woks than Jesus did? Yes, if we are bonded to the Lord Jesus Christ, if Jesus Christ is alive in us, then, just as Jesus accomplishes the miraculous things He did because of His relationship to the Father, so we can accomplish through our connection to Jesus and the Father through their Holy Spirit.

Jesus presents a model for magnifying the Father, Son and Holy Spirit's impact in the world. He begins with 12 apostles, then expanding to hundreds of other disciples, then to millions of disciples throughout all of history. The impact of Jesus is very much felt today by those who continue to sit at His feet to learn and grow in His love. Sadly, we have many who call themselves Christian, but fail to be true disciples, continuing to pursue their God-given purpose and sharing the fullness of their uniqueness. Sadly, there are those who have turned away from Jesus and pursued instead a path away from faith, religion and a supportive faith community. At best this path will produce some good, but allows most people to 'live small' rather than living large in being encouraged and challenged to greater sharing, greater sacrifice, and greater joy in helping others.

When Jesus tells His disciples that in the heart of God there are many dwelling places, He means that absolutely everyone has a place reserved for them if they choose to offer their best to properly care for themselves and for others, especially the poor and needy.

By extension, if WE are made the image and likeness of God as the Book of Genesis tells us, then we, like God, must have dwelling places in us for those we love and who love us in return. So, like God's heart, we are called to expand our hearts to allow greater and greater dwelling places for those who are not in our consciousness, including the poor, the disenfranchised, the immigrant and all who are often relegated to the margins of society. If we do, then, those we interact with will see Jesus, will see the Father and will experience the Holy Spirit through, with and in us.
