From the Desk of Fr. Larry...

My friends, today's Gospel doesn't make a lot of sense to a lot of people. We listen to this familiar story of people seeking work at different parts of the day. The ones who started are promised a fair wage. At the end of the day, the landowner pays everyone the same wage for a full day even though they may have only worked a couple of hours. Doesn't sound fair, does it? Sure didn't sound fair to anyone who worked the full day!

Yet, as we all know, God's way is not always our way. God is never unfair. God treats us all with love, dignity and compassion as His creation.

We can all get caught up in this comparison game with God. Why did God give THEM a great voice and NOT ME? Why did God give THEM athletic ability and NOT ME? Why did God give THEM a great intellect and NOT ME? If God gave us all the same talents and attributes, this would likely be a very boring world. As diverse as the beauty of God's creation, so is the diversity of the gifts that God has given to each of us. All serve a purpose in plan and God's plan is fully realized when we can recognize our gifts, develop them to the fullest, and share them with the world.

The problem is that many of us do not recognize our gifts and do not try to develop them to their fullest. No doubt society and the predominant racist, sexist and individualistic power structures limit the ability of many to move beyond survival into actually thriving in life. It's a tragedy to see such great God-given potential in so many in our underserved communities. What a loss to the world! God is inviting all of us who have been gifted with various skills, talents and attributes to share them with others who have been unable to recognize and/or develop their gifts. If we seek to honor God's love for us, then it is incumbent upon us to live large with our gifts – not in a prideful way, but in a way that encourages and inspires others to do the same.

At times I must admit I wish I had a simpler, less complicated life. Sometimes look at others with envy and say, "Oh, to be them! They seem to have things simpler than I do!" But then God reminds me of the gifts He has given me and tells me, "But, Larry, you are not that person. I made you uniquely for the purpose you were created and that person for their specific purpose. I ask you to simply honor the gifts I have given you and share them to their fullest. It's the same wish I have for the person you are singling out. Is it fair? Yes, because I love each of you equally and offer the same amount of grace to each and everyone. Let them do what they are called to do and focus on what I need you to do. The reward at the end is the same: eternal life and experiencing the infinite manifestations of my Love for you!"


